Though this position is part of a highly collaborative team, it does require a high degree of autonomy so applicants will need to demonstrate a strong foundation in Linux and cli-based administration, an understanding of network protocols (Ethernet, IP, TCP, UDP) and network troubleshooting techniques, experience supporting common network services (DNS, LDAP, Syslog) and hosted services (web, email, voice), and be well versed in security technologies (system hardening, VPNs, PKI).

We value creativity and are more forward-leaning than most shops. Candidates should be able to show a history of innovation and be aware of emerging technologies. If you code, please be prepared to talk about one or more of your more imaginative projects.
